ACSD BOARD OF EDUCATION ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS REGARDING EDUCATION COUNCIL:

- 1.1 The Education Council will report to the Superintendent. In making recommendations concerning problem areas, it will reduce these concerns to problem statements amenable to solutions.
- 1.2 Recommendations from the Education Council will be reviewed by the Superintendent. If the recommendations concern policies, he/she will direct them, along with his/her own, to the Board of Education.
- 1.3 The Education Council will have the opportunity to review and make recommendations whenever the District is establishing or revising its instructional priorities.
