Dear AEEA Members,

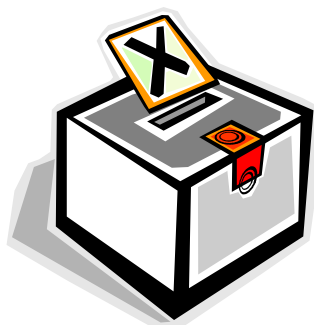
